Warning Against Worldliness

(James 4:1-3) ¹What causes quarrels and what causes fights among you? Is it not this, that your passions¹ are at war within you?² You desire and do not have, so you murder. You covet and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel. You do not have, because you do not ask. ³You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. (emp. mine)

How Did You Treat Others Today?

1. Did you scoff at others as if they were beneath you, or did you lend them an encouraging word?

(Proverbs 21:24) ESV 24. "Scoffer" is the name of the arrogant, haughty man who acts with arrogant pride.

2. Did you sneer at the lack in someone's life, or did you offer a helping hand?

(Proverbs 11:2) ESV 2. When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with the humble is wisdom.

(Proverbs 16:5) ESV 5. Everyone who is arrogant in heart is an abomination to the Lord; be assured, he will not go unpunished.

(Proverbs 29:23) ESV 23. One's pride will bring him low, but he who is lowly in spirit will obtain honor.

3. *Did you offer a soft answer when someone offended you, or did you rise up in anger?*

(Proverbs 15:1) *1 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.*

4. *Did someone fail to produce what you expected of them today? Did you communicate wisely with he/she to find a solution to the problem, or did you curse them violently?*

(James 1:19-20) 19 My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, 20 because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.

(Ecclesiastes 7:9) 9 Do not be quickly provoked in your spirit, for anger resides in the lap of fools.

(Proverbs 15:18) *18 A hot-tempered person stirs up conflict, but the one who is patient calms a quarrel.*

(Proverbs 14:29) *29 Whoever is patient has great understanding, but one who is quick-tempered displays folly.*

(Ephesians 4:30-31) *30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 31 Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.*
